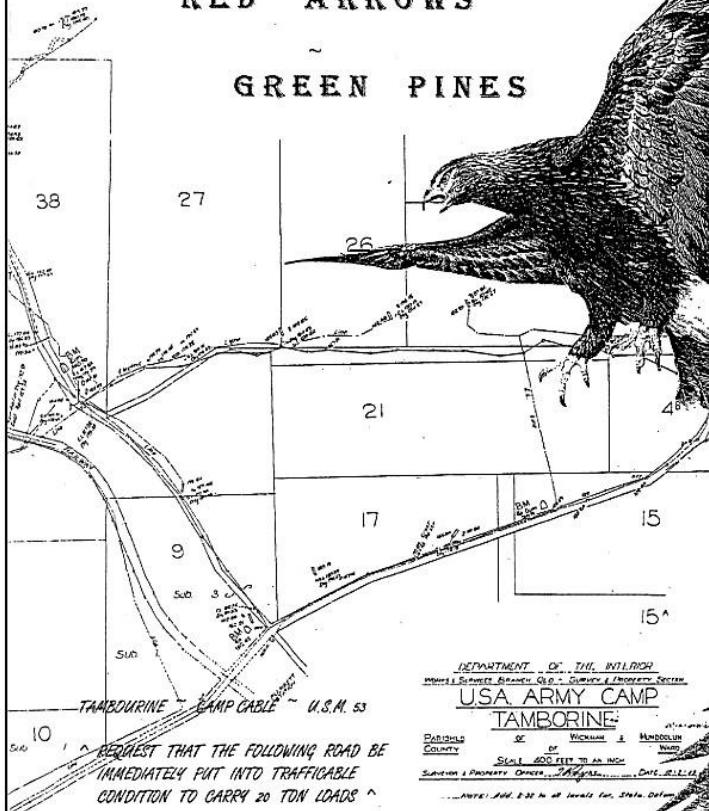

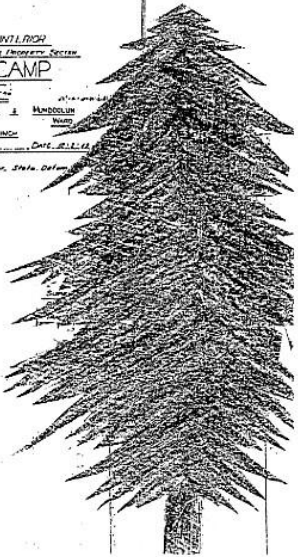

THE PEOPLE WHO HAVE RECORDED THE HISTORIES AND THE HUMAN STORIES OF ALL DIMENSIONS, I AND MANY OTHERS HAVE BEEN PRIVILEGED TO READ, HAVE IN MOST CASES REQUIRED DEDICATED, PERSISTENT AND PATIENT WORK FROM ONE WHO WOULD RECORD THE PAST, THE PRESENT AND WHO CONTEMPLATES THE FUTURE.

IT HAS BEEN MY INTENTION TO BRING TOGETHER AND RECORD AS MUCH OF THE HISTORY OF LOGAN VILLAGE AND CLOSE SURROUNDING AREAS AS POSSIBLE INTO THE LOGAN VILLAGE ITSELF, AND AS SUCH HAVE SPENT MANY YEARS GATHERING THIS INFORMATION. A COLLECTION OF LOGAN VILLAGE RECORDS AND INTERESTING ITEMS OF READING AND PHOTOS HAVE SLOWLY BEEN ACCUMULATED IN THIS COLLECTION. HOWEVER, I EXPECT THESE ARE BUT A SMALL PART OF THE HISTORY AS MANY PERSONAL EXPERIENCES AND MEMORIES WILL NEVER BE RECORDED BY THOSE WHO EXPERIENCE THEM FOR VARIOUS REASONS. THE HISTORY REFERENCED IN THE FOLLOWING PAGES HAS BEEN PUBLISHED IN THE HOPE OF ENCOURAGING THE READER TO TAKE AN INTEREST IN THE HISTORY OF THEIR AREA, BOTH PAST AND PRESENT.

AS WITH ALL HISTORY, MEMORIES AND ACCOUNTS OF EVENTS ARE INDIVIDUAL, AND THE AUTHOR OF THIS NARRATIVE DOES NOT IMPLY THAT ALL FACTS AS STATED ARE CORRECT. HOWEVER, THIS TRACT OF LAND EXTENDING FROM LOGAN VILLAGE AND EAST OF THE RAILWAY LINE TO THE ALBERT RIVER AT TAMBORINE HAS FOUND ITSELF A PLACE IN OUR HISTORY INTENTIONALLY OR NOT.
